

ONIX for Books Codelists Issue 25

This is the consolidated final list of additions and updates for Issue 25 of the ONIX for Books codelists. These changes were ratified by the ONIX International Steering Committee at its meeting during London Book Fair 2014.

Additions and Changes

Within the tables, additions are in red, changes and clarifications in blue and unchanged codes or text are in black.

List 15 – Title type code (ONIX 2.1 and ONIX 3.0)

14	Alternative title	An alternative title that the book is widely known by, whether it appears on the book or not.

Prefer codes 11 and 12 if the alternative title *does* appear on the book.

List 29 – Audience code type (ONIX 2.1 and ONIX 3.0)

Code	Label	Note
27	Intended audience language	Where this is different from the language of the text of the book recorded in <language>. <audiencecodevalue> should be a value from List 74.</audiencecodevalue></language>
28	PEGI rating	Pan European Game Information rating used primarily for video games.

Code 27 is intended for use with books used in language education, for example a book in English which is intended specifically for *Spanish*-speaking learners of English, as opposed to learners whose native language is French or Italian. Note this is only required where the book is wholly in English *and* where it is also customised in some way. If the book has passages (for example an introduction) in Spanish (and therefore both Spanish and English are listed in <Language>) then this code is optional but need not be used. If the book is suitable for learners of English without regard to their native language, then this code should not be used.
